Śri Ganesha Chaturthi

Ganesha Chaturthi, the great Ganesha festival, also known as 'Vināyak Chaturthi' or 'Vināyaka Chavithi' is celebrated by Hindus around the world as the birthday of Lord Ganesha. The festival is observed during the Hindu month of Bhadra (mid-August to mid-September), ending on the day of 'Ananta Chaturdashi'. It is believed that Sri Ganesha bestows his presence on earth for all his devotees during this festival interval of 10 days.

Sri Ganesha is the elephant-headed god and the Lord of power and wisdom. He is worshipped first in any prayers; his names are chanted first before any auspicious work is begun or any worship is undertaken. He is the eldest son of Sri Shiva and Sri Pārvati, and the elder brother of Skanda or Kartikeya.

Our Role: Pray with faith and devotion that He may remove all the obstacles that you experience on the spiritual path. Join us on the Chaturthi event Day and obtain Sri Ganesha's blessings.

- This year we are pleased to announce the 'Vishesh Archana and Ārati' being performed to Sri Ganesha, daily during Ārati time in the evenings - starting from Chaturthi event through 'Ananta Chaturdashi'. Sri Ganesha - Visarjan is taking place on September 12th Thursday on Ananta Chaturdashi, immediately after Mahā Mangala-Ārati.
