Lunar New Year Vikruti Ugadi & Gudi Pavada Tuesday, March 16th 2010

Vikruti is the 24th year of the Hindu Calendar that has a total of 60 years. The New Year is called as Ugadi in Andhra and Karnataka, and Gudi Pavada in Maharsashtra. A very important aspect of the New Year is to go to the temple, listen to the year's predictions (Panchanga Sravanam) by priests, and take the blessings of God for a happy and prosperous year. A special juice, similar to lemonade, is made from six different tastes (sweet, sour, salty, bitter, pungent and astringent), representing life with experiences similar to these six tastes. By drinking this liquid everyone demonstrate that they are ready to swallow one or more of such experiences with courage.
