Sri Hanumān Jayanti - Hanumān Jayanti is celebrated to commemorate the birth of Sri Hanumān. In various regions of the country, Hanumān Jayanti is celebrated on different days. In southern regions, Hanumān Jayanti is celebrated during Margashira/Margazhi Amavasya.

In HTCC, Hanuman Jayanti is being celebrated on Margazhi Amavāsyā. The celebration starts in the morning with special abhisheka for the Deity of Hanumān. After the abhisheka, Hanumān is adorned in a special alankāra. According to Hindu mythology, Sri Hanumān is the son of 'pawan' the god of winds and 'Anjaneē'. He is often referred as 'pawanputra' who is blessed with immense strength. Sri Hanuman is considered as the eleventh Rudra avatār of Sri Siva.
