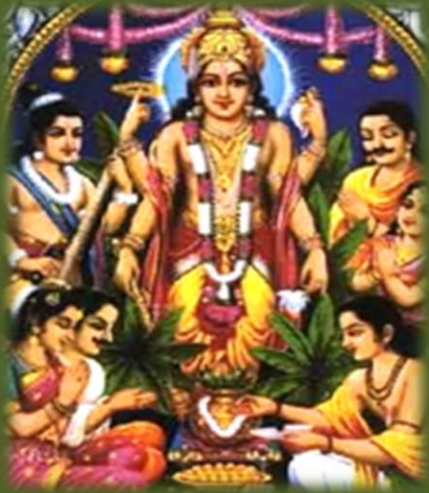

Sri Satyanārāyana Pūja

The Pūja itself is from the Skanda Purana. Suta Maha Muni, a Rishi, narrates the story to a group of Rishis who were performing a 1,000 year yagya for the general benefit of mankind.

They went to Suta Maha Muni, and asked him how an individual having an ethical, life affirming desire, could have that desire fulfilled. Suta Maha Muni tells the Rishis that this Pūja is especially effective during the time of Kali Yuga.

One who reads the story and one Sri Satyanārāyana may remove all the obstacles that you experience on the spiritual path.

Śri Satyanārāyana is none other than Sri Mahā Vishnu - the primordial supreme Śri Man-Narayana.
