Significance of Ashtadala Pāda Padmārādhana Seva

Ashtadala Pāda Padmārādhana Seva – This Seva is conducted in Tirumala temple on every Tuesday after the second bell. This ritual was first introduced in Śrivāri Temple in 1984 on the Golden Jubilee Year of TTD, when a Muslim Devotee offered Lord Śrinivāsa 108 gold lotuses. Later it became an Arjitha Seva called Ashtadala Pāda Padmārādhana Seva. The archaka commences the puja by offering dhupa (arti stick) and dipa (lit the lamp) to the main deity. Then he recites the divine names (108) of the Lord (Ashtotthara Shatha Nāmāvali). While uttering each name of the Lord, one golden lotus is offered at the holy feet of the lord. On completion of the archana to the Mula Virat, archana is offered to Goddesses Lakshmi and Padmāvati. Later Ratha Harati is offered first, followed by ordinary Harati. During this special service, the arjita ticket holders are seated in the Antrala corridor i.e. between the Kulasekhara padi and Bangaru Vākili.

HTCC Bothell is introducing for first time new Arjitha Seva for Lord Śri Venkateswara called Ashtadala Pāda Padmārādhana Seva. **This Seva will be performed on 1**st **Saturday morning of every month after Abhishekam using 108 Ashtadala (eight petal) gold coated silver lotus flowers.** Each flower is made of silver and coated with gold. Devotees can sponsor one gold coated silver flower for a donation of \$108.00. As a token of appreciation, sponsor will get two small lotus flowers.

By performing this Seva, devotees can get Ishwarya Prāpthi (Financial Stability) and get the divine blessings of the Lord Śri Venkateswara Swamy. Devotees also believe that by doing this pooja they can get good health, harmony success and fulfillment of desires.

Please take this opportunity to sponsor an Ashtadala Padmam to Lord Śri Venkateswara as this is once in a lifetime opportunity and great offering to Lord Śri Venkateswara.
